- 1) All areas of the centre remain closed except limited religious, Sports and Essential Hire only. (Kindly use enquiry form on Hire Page for further details).
- 2) Limited opening of our Temple Every Sunday (unless advised): 6pm to 7pm for Darshan only.
- 3) Sunday foyer and main hall for access to temple; toilets remain open for emergency use only.
- 4) Only ONE household will be allowed at a time in the Derasar.
- 5) All visitors and volunteers must wear some form of face covering (e.g. mask, scarf, etc.) and maintain 2 meters 'social distance'.
- 6) Visitors and Volunteers are requested to avoid bringing unnecessary personal possessions (e.g. bags, etc.) into the centre
- 7) Due to limited waiting space we encourage to wait in your own car or in the Car Park.
- 8) Naturally, anyone showing symptoms of, or living with anyone showing symptoms of, COVID-19 (a new continuous cough, a high temperature or a loss of, or change in, their normal sense of taste or smell) may not attend the centre due to the risk that they pose to others for a period of 14 days
- 9) Management ultimately reserves the Right of Entry into the centre.
- 10) Your body temperature will be checked via a contactless scanner and you will be required to sanitise or wash your hands on arrival.
- 11) Please be mindful of new 'one-way' signs and take guidance from the Volunteers.
- 12) For your own safety, you will be required to sanitise or wash your hands again before you leave.

- 13) Visitors are kindly requested not to socialise with other groups or individuals.
- 14) We echo the UK Government's guidance around encouraging the elderly (70+) and those at increased risk of severe disease from COVID-19 to stay at home.
- 15) We request you take extra care of the protocols mentioned above. Children under 12 must be accompanied by a responsible adult at all times to ensure adherence to the safety protocols.
